3	Section 402(i)(2) of the Surface Mining Control and
4	Reclamation Act of 1977 (30 U.S.C. $1232(i)(2)$) is
5	amended—
6	(1) by striking "Subject to" and inserting the
7	following:
8	"(A) IN GENERAL.—Subject to"; and
9	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10	paragraph:
11	"(B) Excess amounts.—
12	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Subject to para-
13	graph (3), and after all transfers referred
14	to in paragraph (1) and subparagraph (A)
15	of this paragraph have been made, any
16	amounts remaining after the application of
17	paragraph (3)(A) (without regard to this
18	subparagraph) shall be transferred to the
19	trustees of the 1974 UMWA Pension Plan
20	and used solely to pay pension benefits re-
21	quired under such plan.
22	"(ii) 1974 UMWA PENSION PLAN.—In
23	this subparagraph the term '1974 UMWA
24	Pension Plan' means a pension plan re-
25	ferred to in section $9701(a)(3)$ of the In-
26	ternal Revenue Code of 1986 but without

regard to whether participation in such plan is limited to individuals who retired in 1976 and thereafter.".
