A BILL

To require formal rulemaking procedures for rules related to health care reform.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Creating Sunshine,
- 5 Participation, and Accountability for our Nation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FORMAL RULEMAKING REQUIREMENT.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any rule issued under a health
- 8 care reform law shall be made on the record after oppor-
- 9 tunity for an agency hearing.

1	(b) Hearing Requirements.—The agency hearing
2	referred to in subsection (a) shall be—
3	(1) open to the public, including to radio and
4	television coverage; and
5	(2) presided over by an officer confirmed by the
6	Senate.
7	(c) Definition.—In this Act, the term "health care
8	reform law" means—
9	(1) the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
10	Act (Public Law 111–148) and the amendments
11	made by that Act; and
12	(2) title I or subtitle B of title II of the Health
13	Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010
14	(Public Law 111–152) and the amendments made
15	by that Act.

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
