1	SECTION 1. EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO
2	PROVIDE PAY AND ALLOWANCES FOR MEM-
3	BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES DURING GOV-
4	ERNMENT SHUTDOWN.
5	(a) Appropriation of Funds for Military Pay
6	AND ALLOWANCES.—If a funding gap occurs during fiscal
7	year 2011 impacting the Armed Forces, amounts are here-
8	by appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not
9	otherwise appropriated, at a rate for operations as pro-
10	vided for military personnel accounts by division A of H.R.
11	1, as passed by the House of Representatives on February
12	19, 2011, for the purpose of providing pay and allowances
13	(without interruption) to members of the Army, Navy, Air
14	Force, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard, including reserve
15	components thereof, who perform active service during the
16	funding gap.
17	(b) Funding Gap Defined.—In this section, the
18	term "funding gap" means any period of time after the
19	beginning of fiscal year 2011 for which interim or full-
20	year appropriations for the military personnel accounts of
21	the Armed Forces for that fiscal year have not been en-
22	acted by a law other than this Act.

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
