## A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to ban the use of the arsenic compound known as roxarsone as a food additive.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Poison-Free Poultry5 Act of 2011".

# 6 SEC. 2. BAN ON USE OF ARSENIC COMPOUND KNOWN AS 7 ROXARSONE AS FOOD ADDITIVE.

8 (a) BAN.—Section 409 of the Federal Food, Drug,
9 and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 348) is amended by adding
10 at the end the following:

"(k) BAN ON USE OF ARSENIC COMPOUND
 ROXARSONE.—The arsenic compound known as
 roxarsone—

4 "(1) shall not be subject to section 201(s)(4);
5 and

6 "(2) is deemed to be an unsafe food additive7 within the meaning of this section.".

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by9 this section shall take effect one year after the date of10 the enactment of this Act.
