## A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds for implementation or enforcement of any Federal mandate to purchase health insurance.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Defund the Individual
- 5 Mandate Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT
2	OR ENFORCE FEDERAL MANDATE TO PUR-
3	CHASE HEALTH INSURANCE.
4	None of the funds appropriated or otherwise made
5	available to any Federal department or agency may be
6	used to implement or enforce any Federal mandate to pur-
7	chase health insurance.

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
