"(9) No cash assistance or medical assistance may 1 be provided under this subsection to any refugee who, 2 3 after entering the United States, travels to a country the 4 government of which the Secretary of State has deter-5 mined has repeatedly provided support for acts of international terrorism pursuant to section 6(j) of the Export 6 Administration Act of 1979 (50 U.S.C. App. 2405(j)), sec-7 tion 620A of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 8 U.S.C. 2371), or section 40 of the Arms Export Control 9 10 Act (22 U.S.C. 2781).".
