## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to reinstate criminal penalties for persons charging veterans unauthorized fees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF PENALTIES FOR CHARG-
- 4 ING VETERANS UNAUTHORIZED FEES.
- 5 (a) In General.—Section 5905 of title 38, United
- 6 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

## 1 " $\S$ 5905. Penalty for certain acts

2	"Except as provided in section 5904 or 1984 of this
3	title, whoever commits any of the following acts shall be
4	fined as provided in title 18, or imprisoned for not more
5	than one year, or both:
6	"(1) In connection with a proceeding before the
7	Department, the act of soliciting, contracting for,
8	charging, or receiving, or attempting to solicit, con-
9	tract for, charge, or receive, any fee or compensation
0	in connection for—
1	"(A) the provision of advice on how to file
2	a claim for benefits under the laws adminis-
3	tered by the Secretary; or
4	"(B) the preparation, presentation, or
5	prosecution of such a claim before the date on
6	which a notice of disagreement is filed in a pro-
7	ceeding on the claim.
8	"(2) The act of unlawfully withholding from
9	any claimant or beneficiary any part of a benefit or
20	claim under the laws administered by the Secretary
21	that is allowed and due to the claimant or bene-
22	ficiary.".
23	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
24	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to acts committed
5	after the date of the engetment of this Act
