# SEC. 2. LIMITATION OF TOTAL DISCRETIONARY APPRO PRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011 TO LEVEL SET BY CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2011.

5 (a) LIMITATION.—The total discretionary appropria-6 tions for fiscal year 2011 may not exceed the total discre-7 tionary appropriations, calculated on an annualized basis, 8 made for such fiscal year by the Continuing Appropria-9 tions Act, 2011 (Public Law 111–242), as amended by 10 the Continuing Appropriations Amendments, 2011 (title 11 I of Public Law 111–322).

(b) DEFINITION OF DISCRETIONARY APPROPRIATIONS.—For purposes of this section, the term "discretionary appropriations" has the meaning given such term
in section 250(c)(7) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 900(c)).
