## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to protect States that have in effect laws or orders with respect to pay to play reform, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "State Ethics Law Pro-
- 5 tection Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. PAY TO PLAY REFORM.
- 7 Section 112 of title 23, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following:

- 1 "(h) Pay To Play Reform.—A State transpor-
- 2 tation department shall not be considered to have violated
- 3 a requirement of this section solely because the State in
- 4 which that State transportation department is located, or
- 5 a local government within that State, has in effect a law
- 6 or an order that limits the amount of money an individual
- 7 or entity that is doing business with a State or local agen-
- 8 cy with respect to a Federal-aid highway project may con-
- 9 tribute to a political party, campaign, candidate, or elected
- 10 official.".
