1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR 4 DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, ZDENKO LISAK. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a) 6 and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 7 Zdenko Lisak may not be removed from the United States, 8 or denied admission to the United States, by reason of 9 any act of his that is a ground for removal or denial of 10 admission and is reflected in the records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service of the Department of Jus-11

tice, or the Visa Office of the Department of State, on
 the date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING ORDER OF RE4 MOVAL.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out5 standing order of removal or deportation, or any finding
6 of deportability, that has been entered against Zdenko
7 Lisak by reason of any act described in subsection (a).
