A BILL

To provide procedures for the selection of the Commandant of the Air Force Institute of Technology, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. ADMINISTRATION OF THE AIR FORCE INSTI-4 TUTE OF TECHNOLOGY.

5 (a) AMENDMENT.—Chapter 901 of title 10, United
6 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 9314a
7 the following new section:

8 "§9314b. Administration of the Air Force Institute of

- 10 "(a) Commandant.—

	-
1	"(1) Selection.—The Commandant of the Air
2	Force Institute of Technology shall be selected by
3	the Secretary of the Air Force.
4	"(2) ELIGIBILITY.—The Commandant shall be
5	one of the following:
6	"(A) ACTIVE-DUTY OFFICERS.—An active-
7	duty officer of the Air Force in a grade not
8	below the grade of colonel, who is assigned or
9	detailed to such position.
10	"(B) CIVILIANS.—A civilian individual, in-
11	cluding an individual who was retired from the
12	Air Force in a grade not below brigadier gen-
13	eral, who has the qualifications appropriate to
14	the position of Commandant and is selected by
15	the Secretary as the best qualified from among
16	candidates for the position in accordance
17	with—
18	"(i) the criteria specified in paragraph
19	(5);
20	"(ii) a process determined by the Sec-
21	retary; and
22	"(iii) other factors the Secretary con-
23	siders relevant.
24	"(3) Consultation of relevant individ-
25	UALS.—Before making an assignment, detail, or se-

1	lection of an individual for the position of Com-
2	mandant, the Secretary shall—
3	"(A) consult with the Air Force Institute
4	of Technology Subcommittee of the Air Univer-
5	sity Board of Visitors;
6	"(B) consider any recommendation of the
7	leadership and faculty of the Air Force Insti-
8	tute of Technology regarding the assignment or
9	selection to that position; and
10	"(C) consider the recommendations of the
11	Air Force Chief of Staff.
12	"(4) FIVE YEAR TERM FOR CIVILIAN COM-
13	MANDANT.—An individual selected for the position
14	of Commandant under paragraph $(1)(B)$ shall serve
15	in that position for a term of not more than five
16	years and may be continued in that position for an
17	additional term of up to five years.
18	"(5) Relevant qualifications.—The quali-
19	fications appropriate for selection of an individual
20	for detail or assignment to the position of Com-
21	mandant include the following:
22	"(A) An academic degree that is either—
23	"(i) a doctorate degree in a field of
24	study relevant to the mission and function

1	of the Air Force Institute of Technology;
2	Or
3	"(ii) a master's degree in a field of
4	study relevant to the mission and function
5	of the Air Force Institute of Technology,
6	but only if—
7	"(I) the individual is an active-
8	duty or retired officer of the Air
9	Force in a grade not below the grade
10	of brigadier general; and
11	"(II) at the time of the selection
12	of that individual as Commandant,
13	the individual permanently appointed
14	to the position of Provost and Aca-
15	demic Dean has a doctorate degree in
16	a field of study relevant to the mission
17	and function of the Air Force Insti-
18	tute of Technology.
19	"(B) A comprehensive understanding of
20	the Department of the Air Force, the Depart-
21	ment of Defense, and joint and combined oper-
22	ations.
23	"(C) Leadership experience at the senior
24	level in a large and diverse organization.

1	"(D) Demonstrated ability to foster and
2	encourage a program of research in order to
3	sustain academic excellence.
4	"(E) Other qualifications, as determined
5	by the Secretary.
6	"(6) SUPPORT.—The Secretary shall detail offi-
7	cers of the Air Force of appropriate grades and
8	qualifications to assist the Commandant in—
9	"(A) the advanced instruction and profes-
10	sional and technical education of students and
11	the provision of research opportunities for stu-
12	dents; and
13	"(B) the administration of the Air Force
14	Institute of Technology.
15	"(b) Provost and Academic Dean.—
16	"(1) IN GENERAL.—There is established at the
17	Air Force Institute of Technology the civilian posi-
18	tion of Provost and Academic Dean.
19	"(2) Appointment.—
20	"(A) APPOINTMENT BY THE SEC-
21	RETARY.—The Provost and Academic Dean
22	shall be appointed by the Secretary for a term
23	of five years.
24	"(B) CONSULTATION.—Before making an
25	appointment to the position of Provost and

1	Academic Dean, the Secretary shall consult
2	with the Air Force Institute of Technology Sub-
3	committee of the Air University Board of Visi-
4	tors and shall consider any recommendation of
5	the leadership and faculty of the Air Force In-
6	stitute of Technology regarding an appointment
7	to that position.
8	"(3) COMPENSATION.—The Provost and Aca-
9	demic Dean is entitled to such compensation as the
10	Secretary prescribes, but not more than the rate of
11	compensation authorized for level IV of the Execu-
12	tive Schedule.
13	"(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
14	"(1) COMMANDANT.—The term 'Commandant'
15	means the Commandant of the Air Force Institute
16	of Technology.
17	"(2) Secretary.—The term 'Secretary' means
18	the Secretary of the Air Force.".
19	(b) TREATMENT OF CURRENT COMMANDANT.—The
20	officer who is serving as Commandant of the Air Force
21	Institute of Technology at the time of the enactment of
22	this Act may serve as acting Commandant until the ap-
23	pointment of a Commandant in accordance with section
24	9314b of title 10, United States Code, as added by sub-
25	section (a).

(c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
 at the beginning of chapter 901 of title 10, United States
 Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
 section 9314a the following new item:
