- 3 SECTION 1. PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER DEATH BENEFITS
- 4 FOR FIRE POLICE OFFICERS.
- 5 Section 1204 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe
- 6 Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796b) is amended—
- 7 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (5) through
- 8 (9) as paragraphs (6) through (10), respectively;

- (2) in paragraph (10)(A) (as so redesignated by paragraph (1) of this section), by inserting "as a fire police officer," after "firefighter,"; and
 - (3) by inserting after paragraph (4) the following new paragraph:
 - "(5) 'fire police officer' means an officially recognized or designated member of a volunteer fire police association or squad who is legally authorized by a State or local government to assist in event crowd control, scene control in emergencies, traffic control in emergencies, and missing person searches;".
