#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Homeowners Flood5 Insurance Awareness Act".

(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any flood elevation
determination for any area in a community that has not,
as of the date of the enactment of this Act, been issued
a Letter of Final Determination for such determination
under the flood insurance map modernization process.

"(B) will utilize the extension to notify property
owners or lessees who are affected by the proposed
flood elevation determinations of the period for appeals and the opportunity to appeal the determinations proposed by the Administrator.".
