To amend the Small Business Act to reform the HUBZone program, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Protect HUBZones5 Act of 2011".

6 SEC. 2. HUBZONE REFORMS.

7 (a) DEFINITIONS ADDED.—Section 3(p) of the Small
8 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632(p)) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

1	"(8) HUBZONE PROGRAM.—The term
2	'HUBZone program' means the program established
3	under section 31.
4	"(9) HUBZONE MAP.—The term 'HUBZone
5	map' means the map used by the Administration to
6	identify HUBZones.".
7	(b) Redesignated Areas.—Section 3(p)(4)(C)(i) of
8	the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. $632(p)(4)(C)(i)$) is
9	amended to read as follows:
10	"(i) 3 years after the first date on
11	which the Administrator publishes a
12	HUBZone map that is based on the results
13	from the 2010 decennial census; or".
