## A BILL

1	SECTION 1. REPEAL OF PPACA AND RECONCILIATION;
2	PRESERVATION OF INDIAN HEALTH CARE IM-
3	PROVEMENT ACT REAUTHORIZATION.
4	Effective as of the last day of the 60-day period be-
5	ginning on the date of the enactment of this Act—
6	(1) the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
7	Act (Public Law 111–148), except for section 10221
8	(relating to the Indian Health Care Improvement
9	Reauthorization and Extension Act of 2009), is re-
10	pealed and the provisions of law amended or re-
11	pealed by such Act (except for provisions of law
12	amended or repealed by such section) are restored or
13	revived as of such day; and
14	(2) title I of the Health Care and Education
15	Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152) is
16	repealed and the provisions of law amended or re-
17	pealed by such title are restored or revived as of
