3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 13 of title 18, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol5 lowing:

6 "§ 250. Displaying nooses in public with intent to in7 timidate

8 "Whoever, with intent to harass or intimidate any 9 person because of that person's race, color, religion, or na-10 tional origin, displays a noose in public shall be fined 11 under this title or imprisoned not more than 2 years, or 12 both.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
at the beginning of chapter 13 of title 18, United States
Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
item:

"250. Displaying nooses in public with intent to intimidate.".
