## A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Girls Protection Act
- 5 of 2011".

## 1 SEC. 2. TRANSPORT FOR FEMALE GENITAL MUTILATION.

- 2 Section 116 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 3 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 4 "(d) Whoever knowingly transports a person in for-
- 5 eign commerce for the purpose of conduct with regard to
- 6 that person that would be a violation of subsection (a) if
- 7 the conduct occurred within the United States, or at-
- 8 tempts to do so, shall be fined under this title or impris-
- 9 oned not more than 5 years, or both.".
