## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Flood Control Facility

5 Maintenance Clarification Act".

### 6 SEC. 2. PERMITS FOR DREDGED OR FILL MATERIAL.

7 Section 404(f) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-

8 trol Act (42 U.S.C. 1344(f)) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (1)(B) by inserting "channels,
basins," after "such as"; and
(2) by adding at the end the following:
"(3) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(B), the
term 'maintenance' includes the removal of sedi ment, debris, and vegetation from structures de scribed in that paragraph.".
