- 5 (a) Exclusion.—Section 5117(d)(1) of title 49,
- 6 United States Code, is amended—
- 7 (1) in subparagraph (B), by striking "and" at
- 8 the end;

1	(2) in subparagraph (C), by striking the period
2	at the end and inserting "; and; and
3	(3) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(D) a service vehicle carrying diesel fuel
5	in quantities of 3,785 liters (1,000 gallons) or
6	less that is—
7	"(i) driven by a class A commercial
8	driver's license holder who is a custom har-
9	vester, an agricultural retailer, an agricul-
10	tural business employee, an agricultural
11	cooperative employee, or an agricultural
12	producer; and
13	"(ii) clearly marked with a placard
14	reading 'Diesel Fuel'.".
15	(b) Exemption.—Section 31315(b) of title 49,
16	United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
17	following:
18	"(8) Hazardous materials endorsement
19	EXEMPTION.—The Secretary shall exempt all class A
20	commercial driver's license holders who are custom
21	harvesters, agricultural retailers, agricultural busi-
22	ness employees, agricultural cooperative employees,
23	or agricultural producers from the requirement to
24	obtain a hazardous material endorsement under part
25	383 of title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, while

operating a service vehicle carrying diesel fuel in quantities of 3,785 liters (1,000 gallons) or less if the tank containing such fuel is clearly marked with a placard reading 'Diesel Fuel'.".
