- 5 Section 1121(a) of the Elementary and Secondary
- 6 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6331(a)) is amended—

1	(1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
2	striking "a total of 1 percent to provide assistance
3	to";
4	(2) in paragraph (1), by inserting ".5 percent
5	to provide assistance to" before "the outlying"; and
6	(3) in paragraph (2), by inserting ".75 percent
7	to provide assistance to" before "the Secretary".
