4 This Act may be cited as the "Bringing Economic5 Advancement and Coastal Health Act".

1 SEC. 2. BEACH NOURISHMENT.

2 Section 156 of the Water Resources Development Act
3 of 1976 (42 U.S.C. 1962d–5f) is amended—

4 (1) by striking "The" and inserting "(a) The";
5 (2) by inserting before the period at the end the
6 following: "or after the date of the last estimated
7 periodic nourishment as contemplated in the Chief's
8 Report, whichever is later"; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 "(b) Before the end of the fifty-year period referred to in subsection (a), the Secretary of the Army, acting 11 through the Chief of Engineers, shall, subject to the avail-12 ability of appropriations therefor, undertake a review of 13 14 a project to which subsection (a) applies to evaluate the feasibility of continuing Federal participation in the 15 project and shall make a recommendation to the Con-16 17 gress.".

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
