- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5112 of title 31, United

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall take effect at the end of the 30-day
period beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.
SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON OVERPRODUCTION OF \$1 COINS.
Section 5112 of title 31, United States Code, is
amended by adding at the end the following new sub section:

8 "(w) RESTRICTION ON OVERPRODUCTION OF \$1 9 COINS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-10 tion, no \$1 coin may be minted or issued under this sec-11 tion during any period in which the number of \$1 coins 12 issued, but not in circulation, is more than 10 percent of 13 the number of \$1 coins in circulation.".
