1SEC. 2. ACTIVE SHOOTER TRAINING FOR PERSONNEL RE-2SPONSIBLE FOR SECURITY AT DEPARTMENT3OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CENTERS.

4 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall establish poli-5 cies and promulgate guidelines to ensure that law enforce-6 ment personnel charged with security functions at Depart-7 ment of Veterans Affairs medical centers receive active 8 shooter training, as described in finding 4.3 of the Depart-9 ment of Defense document entitled "Protecting the Force: 10 Lessons from Fort Hood".

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
