- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE.
- 4 The last undesignated paragraph under the heading
- 5 "Management and Administration—Administrative Provi-
- 6 sions" in title II of the Departments of Veterans Affairs
- 7 and Housing and Urban Development, and Independent
- 8 Agencies Appropriations Act, 1992 (Public Law 102–139;
- 9 105 Stat. 760) is amended to read as follows:

- 1 "For purposes of the Native American Housing As-
- 2 sistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (25 U.S.C.
- 3 4101 et seq.) and any successor Federal housing program,
- 4 members of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe who reside within the
- 5 State of Arizona in the communities of Guadalupe, Tuc-
- 6 son, Coolidge, Eloy, Chandler, and Scottsdale, shall be
- 7 considered (without fiscal year limitation) as residing on
- 8 an Indian reservation or Indian area.".
