  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Cutting Out Inefficient
  - 5 and Needless Spending Act of 2011" or the "COINS Act
  - 6 of 2011".

### 1 SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF PRESIDENTIAL \$1 COIN PROGRAM

- 2 **DURING SURPLUS.**
- 3 Section 5112(n)(8) of title 31, United States Code,
- 4 is amended by adding on the end the following: "The Sec-
- 5 retary shall suspend issuance of coins under this sub-
- 6 section during any period for which the Secretary deter-
- 7 mines that the surplus supply of \$1 coins exceeds the rea-
- 8 sonable circulation needs for one year.".
- 9 SEC. 3. REMOVAL OF UNMIXED SUPPLIES REQUIREMENT.
- Section 5112(p)(3)(D) of title 31, United States
- 11 Code, is amended by striking "ensuring that" and all that
- 12 follows through "(ii) circulating coins" and inserting the
- 13 following: "ensuring that circulating coins".
