3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hudson Valley VA
- 5 Health Care System Campus Protection Act".

1SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN DEPART-2MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS LAND AND IM-3PROVEMENTS IN THE HUDSON VALLEY4HEALTHCARE SYSTEM.

5 (a) MONTROSE VAMC.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may not declare as excess to the needs of the 6 7 Franklin Delano Roosevelt Campus of the Department of 8 Veterans Affairs Hudson Valley Healthcare System (here-9 inafter referred to as the "Montrose VAMC") or otherwise 10 take any action to lease, sell, exchange, trade, auction, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, or reduce the acreage 11 12 of, Federal land and improvements at the Montrose 13 VAMC, consisting of approximately 184 acres of land lo-14 cated at 2094 Albany Post Road, Montrose, New York. 15 (b) CASTLE POINT.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-16 fairs may not declare as excess to the needs of the Castle Point Campus of the Department of Veterans Affairs 17 18 Hudson Valley Healthcare System or otherwise take any 19 action to lease, sell, exchange, trade, auction, transfer, or 20 otherwise dispose of, or reduce the acreage of, Federal land and improvements at the Castle Point Campus lo-21 22 cated at Route 9D, Castle Point, New York.
