INCREASE IN REQUIRED MEDIGAP LOSS RATIO. 1 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1882(r)(1)(A) of the So-2 3 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ss(r)(1)(A)) is amend-4 ed— 5 (1) by striking "75 percent" and inserting "85 percent"; and 6 (2) by striking "65 percent" and inserting "80 7 percent". 8 9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by subsection (a) shall apply to policies for policy years begin-10

11 ning on or after January 1, 2014.
