7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 105(j)(2) of the Internal
8 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

(1) by inserting "or established by or on behalf
 of a State or political subdivision thereof" after
 "public retirement system", and
 (2) by inserting "or 501(c)(9)" after "section

5 115" in subparagraph (B) thereof.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section shall apply to payments after the date of the
8 enactment of this Act.
