- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Leadership PAC Limi-
- 5 tation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITING CONVERSION OF LEADERSHIP PAC
- 7 FUNDS TO PERSONAL USE.
- 8 (a) Prohibition.—Section 313(b)(1) of the Federal
- 9 Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 439a(b)(1)) is
- 10 amended by inserting after "subsection (a)" the following:

- 1 "or funds of a leadership PAC (as defined in section
- 2 304(i)(8)(B))".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to elections occur-
- 5 ring on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
