A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of a small parcel of National Forest System land in Pound, Virginia.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, MULLINS AND STURGILL

4 CEMETERY AND ADJOINING TRACT, JEFFER5 SON NATIONAL FOREST, VIRGINIA.

6 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Ag-7 riculture shall convey, without consideration, to the 8 Mullins and Sturgill Cemetery Association of Pound, Vir-9 ginia (in this section referred to as the "recipient"), all 10 right, title, and interest of the United States in and to a parcel of National Forest System land in the Jefferson
 National Forest in Wise County, Virginia, consisting of
 not more than 1.25 acres and containing the Mullins and
 Sturgill Cemetery and its access road.

5 (b) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The conveyance
6 under subsection (a) shall be subject to the condition that
7 the recipient accept the real property described in such
8 subsection in its condition at the time of the conveyance,
9 commonly known as conveyance "as is".

(c) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
borne by the recipient.

(d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
Secretary may require such additional terms and conditions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
(a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
interests of the United States.
