A BILL

To provide relief to the Pottawatomi Nation in Canada for settlement of certain claims against the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SETTLEMENT OF CERTAIN CLAIMS.
- 4 (a) Authorization for Payment.—Notwith-
- 5 standing any other provision of law, subject to subsection
- 6 (b), the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay to the
- 7 Pottawatomi Nation in Canada \$1,830,000 from amounts
- 8 appropriated under section 1304 of title 31, United States
- 9 Code.

- 1 (b) Payment in Accordance With Stipulation
- 2 FOR RECOMMENDATION OF SETTLEMENT.—The payment
- 3 under subsection (a) shall—
- 4 (1) be made in accordance with the terms and
- 5 conditions of the Stipulation for Recommendation of
- 6 Settlement dated May 22, 2000, entered into be-
- 7 tween the Pottawatomi Nation in Canada and the
- 8 United States (referred to in this section as the
- 9 "Stipulation for Recommendation of Settlement");
- 10 and
- 11 (2) be included in the report of the Chief Judge
- of the United States Court of Federal Claims re-
- garding Congressional Reference No. 94–1037X,
- submitted to the Senate on January 4, 2001, in ac-
- 15 cordance with sections 1492 and 2509 of title 28,
- 16 United States Code.
- 17 (c) Full Satisfaction of Claims.—The payment
- 18 under subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of all
- 19 claims of the Pottawatomi Nation in Canada against the
- 20 United States that are referred to or described in the Stip-
- 21 ulation for Recommendation of Settlement.
- 22 (d) Nonapplicability.—Notwithstanding any other
- 23 provision of law, the Indian Tribal Judgment Funds Use

- 1 or Distribution Act (25 U.S.C. 1401 et seq.) does not
- 2 apply to the payment under subsection (a).
