A BILL

To make supplemental appropriations for disaster relief for fiscal year 2011.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
- 4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for fis-
- 5 cal year 2011, and for other purposes, namely:
- 6 Sec. 101. For an additional amount for "Department
- 7 of Agriculture—Farm Service Agency—Emergency Con-
- 8 servation Program" for expenses resulting from any event
- 9 occurring in 2011 that is designated as a major disaster

- 1 pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and
- 2 Emergency Assistance Act (4210 U.S.C. 5122(2)),
- 3 \$151,000,000, to remain available until expended.
- 4 Sec. 102. For an additional amount for "Department
- 5 of Agriculture—Conservation Programs—Natural Re-
- 6 sources Conservation Service—Emergency Watershed
- 7 Protection Program", for expenses resulting from any
- 8 event occurring in 2011 that is designated as a major dis-
- 9 aster pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
- 10 and Emergency Assistance Act (4210 U.S.C. 5122(2)),
- 11 \$187,500,000, to remain available until expended: Pro-
- 12 vided, That for an additional amount for such expenses,
- 13 of the unobligated balances of amounts made available for
- 14 such account by Public Law 108-199, Public Law 109-
- 15 234, and Public Law 110–28, not to exceed \$31,000,000
- 16 may be used, to remain available until expended.
- 17 Sec. 103. Each amount made available by this Act
- 18 is designated as an emergency pursuant to section 3(c)(1)
- 19 of H. Res. 5 (112th Congress) and as an emergency re-
- 20 quirement pursuant to section 403(a) of S. Con. Res. 13
- 21 (111th Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget
- 22 for fiscal year 2010.
- This Act may be cited as the "Helping Devastated
- 24 Farmers Act of 2011".
