## A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to allow urbanized area formula grants for public transportation projects to be used for operating costs in urbanized areas with a population of at least 200,000, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Transit
- 5 Through Increased Flexibility Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. URBANIZED AREA FORMULA GRANTS.
- 7 Section 5307(b) of title 49, United States Code, is
- 8 amended—

1	(1) by striking paragraph $(1)(E)$ and inserting
2	the following:
3	"(E) operating costs of equipment and fa-
4	cilities for use in public transportation in an ur-
5	banized area with a population of at least
6	200,000, if—
7	"(i) the term of the grant does not ex-
8	ceed one year; and
9	"(ii) the funds are derived from
10	grants awarded under subparagraph (A),
11	(B), or (C) pursuant to a request approved
12	by the Secretary under paragraph (4);
13	and"; and
14	(2) by adding at the end the following:
15	"(4) Use of grants for operating assist-
16	ANCE IN URBANIZED AREAS WITH A POPULATION OF
17	AT LEAST 200,000.—
18	"(A) Submission of requests.—A re-
19	cipient of a grant under paragraph (1)(A),
20	(1)(B), or (1)(C) for an urbanized area with a
21	population of at least 200,000 may submit a re-
22	quest to the Secretary that all or any portion
23	of the amounts of the grant be made available
24	for operating costs under paragraph (1)(E).

1	"(B) Information to be included in
2	REQUESTS.—A request submitted by a recipient
3	under subparagraph (A) shall include—
4	"(i) documentation illustrating re-
5	duced tax revenue or appropriations of
6	funds available to the recipient over the
7	previous year;
8	"(ii) documentation of increased fuel
9	costs or any other factor affecting the
10	budget of the recipient for operating costs;
11	and
12	"(iii) a certification that the amount
13	requested under subparagraph (A) does
14	not exceed the reductions in tax revenues
15	and appropriations of funds documented
16	under clause (i).
17	"(C) Approval and disapproval of re-
18	QUESTS.—The Secretary shall approve or dis-
19	approve a request submitted under subpara-
20	graph (A) based on—
21	"(i) the impact of approval or dis-
22	approval on the continuity and cost of
23	service provided by the recipient;
24	"(ii) the impact of approval or dis-
25	approval on the ability of the recipient to

1	meet goals established under sections
2	5303, 5304, and 5306; and
3	"(iii) an assessment of the informa-
4	tion submitted under subparagraph (B).
5	"(D) DEADLINE FOR CONSIDERATION OF
6	REQUESTS.—If the Secretary does not approve
7	or disapprove a request submitted under sub-
8	paragraph (A) on or before the 60th day fol-
9	lowing the date of receipt of the request, the re-
10	quest shall be deemed approved.".

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
