 - 7 TIVITY SPENDING REQUIREMENT.
 - 8 Section 133(d) of title 23, United States Code, is
 - 9 amended—

1	(1) by striking paragraph (2); and
2	(2) in paragraph (5)(A) by striking "funded
3	from the allocation required under paragraph (2)".
