- 3 SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL ALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO INSU-
- 4 LAR AREAS.
- 5 Section 2604 of the Low-Income Home Energy As-
- 6 sistance Act of 1981 (42 U.S.C. 8623) is amended—

1	(1) in subsection $(a)(1)(A)$ , by striking "sub-
2	section (b)(1)" and inserting "subsection (b)(1)(A)";

4	(2) in subsection (b)(1)—
5	(A) by striking "(b)(1)" before "The Sec-
6	retary shall apportion not less than" and insert-
7	ing "(b)(1)(A)";
8	(B) by striking "under this paragraph"
9	and inserting "under this subparagraph", each
10	place it appears; and
11	(C) by adding at the end the following new
12	subparagraph:
13	"(B) Beginning in fiscal year 2013, and for each fis-
14	cal year thereafter, the Secretary shall allocate not less
15	than 30 percent of the amount appropriated pursuant to
16	section 2602(d) for such fiscal year to the jurisdictions
17	to which subparagraph (A) applies to provide supple-
18	mentary funds to such jurisdictions for carrying out this
19	title on the basis of need among such jurisdictions.".
