A BILL

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Local School Foods
3	Act".
4	SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM FOR PURCHASE OF FRESH FRUITS
5	AND VEGETABLES FOR SCHOOLS AND SERV-
6	ICE INSTITUTIONS.
7	Section 10603 of the Farm Security and Rural In-
8	vestment Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C. $612c-4$) is amended—
9	(1) in subsection (a), by inserting "or to pro-
10	vide grants under the pilot program described in
11	subsection (c)" after "crops";
12	(2) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
13	section (d); and
14	(3) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
15	lowing:
16	"(c) Pilot Program for Purchase of Fresh
17	FRUITS AND VEGETABLES FOR SCHOOLS AND SERVICE
18	Institutions.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—Of the amount specified in subsection (a), the Secretary of Agriculture shall use not more than \$1,000,000 to conduct a pilot program under which the Secretary will give not more than three participating States the option of receiving a grant in an amount equal to the value of the commodities that the participating State would oth-

erwise receive under this section for each of fiscal years 2012 and 2013.

"(2) USE OF GRANT FUNDS.—A participating State receiving a grant under this subsection may use the grant funds solely to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables for distribution to schools and service institutions in the State participating in the food service programs under the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1751 et seq.) and the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1771 et seq.).

"(3) SELECTION OF PARTICIPATING STATES.—
The Secretary shall select participating States from applications submitted by the States. Each participating State shall be from a different Department of Agriculture region.

"(4) Reporting requirements.—

"(A) SCHOOL AND SERVICE INSTITUTION REQUIREMENT.—Schools and service institutions in a participating State shall keep records of purchases of fresh fruits and vegetables made using the grant funds and report such records to the State.

"(B) STATE REQUIREMENT.—Each participating State shall submit to the Secretary a

2	the State, including information on—
3	"(i) the amount and value of each
4	type of fresh fruit and vegetable purchased
5	by the State; and
6	"(ii) the benefit provided by such pur-
7	chases in conducting the school food serv-
8	ice in the State, including meeting school
9	meal requirements "

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
