A BILL

To prohibit the payment of death gratuities to the surviving heirs of deceased Members of Congress.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITING PAYMENT OF GRATUITIES TO
- 4 SURVIVORS OF MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.
- 5 (a) Prohibition.—No payment may be made from
- 6 the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives,
- 7 the contingent fund of the Senate, or any other appro-
- 8 priated funds for a death gratuity payment to the widow,
- 9 widower, or heirs-at-law of any Member of Congress who

- 1 dies after the commencement of the Congress to which the
- 2 Member has been elected.
- 3 (b) No Effect on Other Payments to Sur-
- 4 VIVORS.—Nothing in subsection (a) shall be construed to
- 5 prohibit or affect the payment to any individual of any
- 6 unpaid balance or salary or other sums due to a Member
- 7 of Congress who dies after the commencement of the Con-
- 8 gress to which the Member has been elected.
- 9 SEC. 2. DEFINITION.
- 10 For purposes of this Act, a "Member of Congress"
- 11 means a Senator or a Representative in, or Delegate or
- 12 Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
