HOLLINGS MANUFACTURING EXTENSION PARTNER-2 SHIP PROGRAM COST SHARING. 3 Section 25(c) of the National Institute of Standards and Technology Act (15 U.S.C. 278k(c)) is amended by 4 5 adding at the end the following: 6 "(9) Notwithstanding paragraphs (1), (3), and 7 (5), for fiscal year 2012 through fiscal year 2013, 8 the Secretary may not provide to a Center more 9 than 50 percent of the costs incurred by such Center 10 and may not require that a Center's cost share ex-11 ceed 50 percent. 12 "(10) Not later than 1 year after the date of 13 enactment of this paragraph, the Secretary shall 14 submit to Congress a report on the cost share requirements under the program.
