2 Subsection (a) of section 103 of the McKinney-Vento
3 Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11302(a)) is amend4 ed—

5 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking "and" at the
6 end;

7 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking the paragraph
8 at the end and inserting "; and"; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new10 paragraph:

11 ((3)(A) a child or youth who has been verified 12 as homeless, as such term is defined in section 13 725(2)(B)(i) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless As-14 sistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11434a(2)(B)(i)), by a local 15 educational agency homeless liaison, designated pur-16 suant to section 722(g)(1)(J)(ii) of the McKinney-17 (42)Vento Homeless Assistance Act U.S.C. 18 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii)), and the family of such child or 19 youth;

20 "(B) a youth verified as homeless by the
21 director of a program funded under the Run22 away and Homeless Youth Act (42 U.S.C. 5701
23 et seq.), or a designee of the director;

24 "(C) a child verified as homeless under
25 section 602 of the Individuals with Disabilities
26 Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1401) by the director

or the designee of such program, and the family
 of such child; and
 "(D) a child verified as homeless under
 section 637 of the Head Start Act (42 U.S.C.
 9832) by the director or designee of such pro gram, and the family of such child.".
