## A BILL

4	(a) In General.—Section 106(b)(2) of the Child
5	Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (42 U.S.C.
6	5106a(b)(2)) is amended—
7	(1) in subparagraph (F), by striking "and" at
8	the end;
9	(2) in subparagraph (G), by striking the period
10	at the end and inserting "; and"; and
11	(3) by adding at the end the following:
12	"(H) an assurance in the form of a certifi-
13	cation by the Governor of the State that the
14	State has in effect and is enforcing a State law
15	providing for a criminal penalty on any person
16	18 years of age or older who fails to report to
17	a State or local law enforcement official or child
18	protective services that the person has knowl-
19	edge of child abuse or neglect that occurred in
20	the State.".
21	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
22	subsection (a) shall take effect on December 31, 2013.
