A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to establish a program to assist veterans to acquire commercial driver's licenses, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Accelerated
- 5 License Obtainment and Recertification Act of 2011" or
- 6 the "VALOR Act of 2011".
- 7 SEC. 2. PROGRAM TO ASSIST VETERANS TO ACQUIRE COM-
- 8 MERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES.
- 9 (a) Establishment.—Not later than 1 year after
- 10 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-

- 1 portation, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense
- 2 and in cooperation with the States, shall establish acceler-
- 3 ated licensing procedures to assist veterans to acquire
- 4 commercial driver's licenses.
- 5 (b) ACCELERATED LICENSING PROCEDURES.—The
- 6 procedures established under subsection (a) shall be de-
- 7 signed to be applicable to any veteran who—
- 8 (1) is attempting to acquire a commercial driv-
- 9 er's license; and
- 10 (2) obtained, during military service, driving ex-
- perience that, in the determination of the Secretary,
- makes the use of accelerated licensing procedures
- appropriate.
- 14 (c) Definitions.—In this section, the following defi-
- 15 nitions apply:
- 16 (1) COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.—The
- term "commercial driver's license" has the meaning
- given that term in section 31301(3) of title 49,
- 19 United States Code.
- 20 (2) STATE.—The term "State" has the mean-
- 21 ing given that term in section 31301(13) of title 49,
- 22 United States Code.

1	(3) Veteran.—The term "veteran" has the
2	meaning given that term in section 101(2) of title
3	38, United States Code.
