A BILL

To amend the Herger-Feinstein Quincy Library Group Forest Recovery Act to extend and expand the scope of the pilot forest management project required by that Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF HERGER-FEINSTEIN**
4 **QUINCY LIBRARY GROUP FOREST RECOVERY**
5 **ACT.**

6 *(a) EXTENSION.—Subsection (g) of the Herger-Fein-*
7 *stein Quincy Library Group Forest Recovery Act (title IV*
8 *of the Department of the Interior and Related Agencies Ap-*
9 *propriations Act, 1999, as contained in section 101(e) of*
10 *division A of Public Law 105–277; 16 U.S.C. 2104 note)*
11 *is amended to read as follows:*

12 “*(g) TERM OF PILOT PROJECT.—*

13 “*(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall conduct*
14 *the pilot project until the earlier of the following:*

15 “*(A) September 30, 2022.*

16 “*(B) The date on which the Secretary com-*
17 *pletes amendment or revision of the land and re-*
18 *source management plans for the National Forest*
19 *System lands included in the pilot project area.*

20 “*(2) FOREST PLAN AMENDMENTS.—When the Re-*
21 *gional Forester for Region 5 initiates the process to*
22 *amend or revise the land and resource management*
23 *plans for the pilot project area, the process shall in-*
24 *clude preparation of at least one alternative that in-*
25 *corporates the pilot project and area designations*

1 under subsection (b), the resource management activities described in subsection (d), and other aspects of
2 the Quincy Library Group Community Stability Proposal.”.

5 (b) EXPANSION OF PILOT PROJECT AREA.—Subsection
6 (b) of the Herger-Feinstein Quincy Library Group Forest
7 Recovery Act is amended by adding at the end the following
8 new paragraph:

9 “(3) EXPANSION OF PILOT PROJECT AREA.—The
10 Secretary may expand the pilot project area to include all National Forest System lands within California or Nevada that lie within the Sierra Nevada and Cascade Province, Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, and Inyo National Forest. These lands may be managed using the same strategy, guidelines and resource management activities outlined in this section or developed to meet local forest and community needs and conditions.”.

20 (c) ROADLESS AREA PROTECTION.—Subsection (c)(4)
21 of the Herger-Feinstein Quincy Library Group Forest Re-
22 covery Act is amended by adding at the end the following
23 new sentence: “However, those areas designated as ‘De-
24 ferred’ on the map, but located in Tehama County, south
25 and west of Lassen Peak, are deemed to be designated as

1 ‘Available for Group Selection’ and shall be managed ac-
2 cordingly under subsection (d).”.

3 (d) GROUP SELECTION REQUIREMENT.—Subpara-
4 graph (A) of subsection (d)(2) of the Herger-Feinstein Quin-
5 cy Library Group Forest Recovery Act is amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (A) GROUP SELECTION.—After September
8 30, 2012, group selection on an average acreage
9 of .57 percent of the pilot project area land shall
10 occur each year of the pilot project.”.
