- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Enabling Energy Sav-

- 6 SEC. 2. INNOVATIVE COMPONENT TECHNOLOGIES.

- (2) by adding at the end the following new paragraph:
- "(6) Innovative component tech-Nologies.—Subparagraph (C) of paragraph (1) shall not apply to a walk-in cooler or walk-in freezer components if the manufacturer has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Secretary that the component model reduces energy consumption at least as much as if such subparagraph were to apply. In support of any demonstration under this paragraph, a manufacturer shall provide to the Secretary all data and technical information necessary to fully evaluate its application."
