A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. TECHNOLOGY VIABILITY.

- 4 Section 1702 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42
- 5 U.S.C. 16512) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 6 lowing new subsection:
- 7 "(I) TECHNOLOGY VIABILITY.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary is authorized 1 2 to take appropriate actions to ensure the viability of 3 a technology described in section 1703(b) with a po-4 tential applicant for a loan guarantee under this 5 title. Funding for carrying out this subsection may 6 be derived, to the extent provided in appropriations 7 Acts, from amounts otherwise authorized to be ap-8 propriated for carrying out this title or for other ad-9 ministrative purposes of the Department of Energy.

10 "(2) FAILURE TO ACHIEVE CRITERIA.—If the 11 Secretary determines that a person has not achieved 12 technical criteria as provided under an agreement 13 entered into between that person and the Secretary 14 pursuant to this subsection, that person shall, as 15 soon as practicable, surrender to the Secretary cus-16 tody, possession, and control of, and title to, any 17 real or personal property leased by that person from 18 the Secretary or otherwise acquired or used, using 19 funds provided under this subsection.".
