## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to modify a provision relating to minimum penalties for repeat offenders for driving while intoxicated or driving under the influence, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MINIMUM PENALTIES FOR REPEAT OFFEND-**  
4                       **ERS FOR DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED OR**  
5                       **DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE.**

6       Section 164(a) of title 23, United States Code, is  
7       amended—

8               (1) by striking paragraph (3);

1           (2) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as  
2 paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively; and

3           (3) in subparagraph (A) of paragraph (4) (as  
4 so redesignated), by striking clauses (i) and (ii) and  
5 inserting the following:

6                   “(i) a suspension of all driving privi-  
7 leges for not less than 1 year; or

8                   “(ii) a suspension of unlimited driving  
9 privileges for 1 year, with limited driving  
10 privileges permitted subject to restrictions  
11 and limited exemptions established under  
12 State law, if an ignition interlock device is  
13 installed for not less than 1 year on each  
14 of the motor vehicles owned or operated, or  
15 both, by the individual;”.
