- 4 Francisco Bay Area Recycled Water Coalition partici-
- 5 pating agencies to fund the projects and may include in
- 6 such agreements a provision for the reimbursement of con-
- 7 struction costs, including those construction costs incurred
- 8 prior to the enactment of this Act, subject to appropria-
- 9 tions made available for the Federal share of the project
- 10 under sections 1642 through 1656 of the Reclamation
- 11 Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act
- 12 and the sections added to such Act under subsection (a).
- 13 (c) Clerical Amendments.—The table of sections
