- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Healthy Communities
- 5 Water Supply Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM FOR ALTERNATIVE WATER
- 7 SOURCE PROJECTS.
- 8 (a) Selection of Projects.—Section 220(d)(2) of
- 9 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.
- 10 1300(d)(2)) is amended by inserting before the period at

- 1 the end the following: "or whether the project is located
- 2 in an area which is served by a public water system serving
- 3 10,000 individuals or fewer".
- 4 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
- 5 220(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33
- 6 U.S.C. 1300(j)) is amended by striking "\$75,000,000 for
- 7 fiscal years 2002 through 2004" and inserting
- 8 "\$125,000,000".
