- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Polar Bear Delisting

- 6 SEC. 2. DELISTING OF POLAR BEAR AS THREATENED SPE-
- 7 CIES.
- 8 The determination by the United States Fish and
- 9 Wildlife of the threatened status for the polar bear (Ursus
- 10 maritimus) under the Endangered Species Act of 1973

- 1 (16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.), published May 15, 2008 (73
- 2 Fed. Reg. 28211 et seq.), and the listing of such species
- 3 as a threatened species under that Act pursuant to such
