## A BILL

To direct the Architect of the Capitol to acquire a statue of "The Unknown Slave" for permanent display in Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. STATUE OF "THE UNKNOWN SLAVE".
- 4 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
- 5 ment of this Act, the Architect of the Capitol (hereafter
- 6 in this Act referred to as the "Architect") shall solicit bids
- 7 and enter into an agreement for the creation of a statue
- 8 of "The Unknown Slave". The Architect shall acquire and

- 1 permanently display that statue in Emancipation Hall in
- 2 the Capitol Visitor Center.
- SEC. 2. CONSULTATION WITH CONGRESSIONAL BLACK
- 4 CAUCUS.
- 5 The Architect shall carry out this Act in consultation
- 6 with the Congressional Black Caucus.
