1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Accountability in3 Grants Act of 2012".

4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST FUNDING CERTAIN FOR5 EIGN PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVI6 TIES.

7 Section 103 of the Clean Air Act is amended by add-8 ing at the end the following:

9 "(1) PROHIBITION AGAINST FUNDING FOREIGN PRO-10 GRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES.—The Administrator 11 shall not award any grant, contract, cooperative agree-12 ment, or other financial assistance under this section for 13 any program, project, or activity to occur outside the 14 United States and its territories and possessions.".
